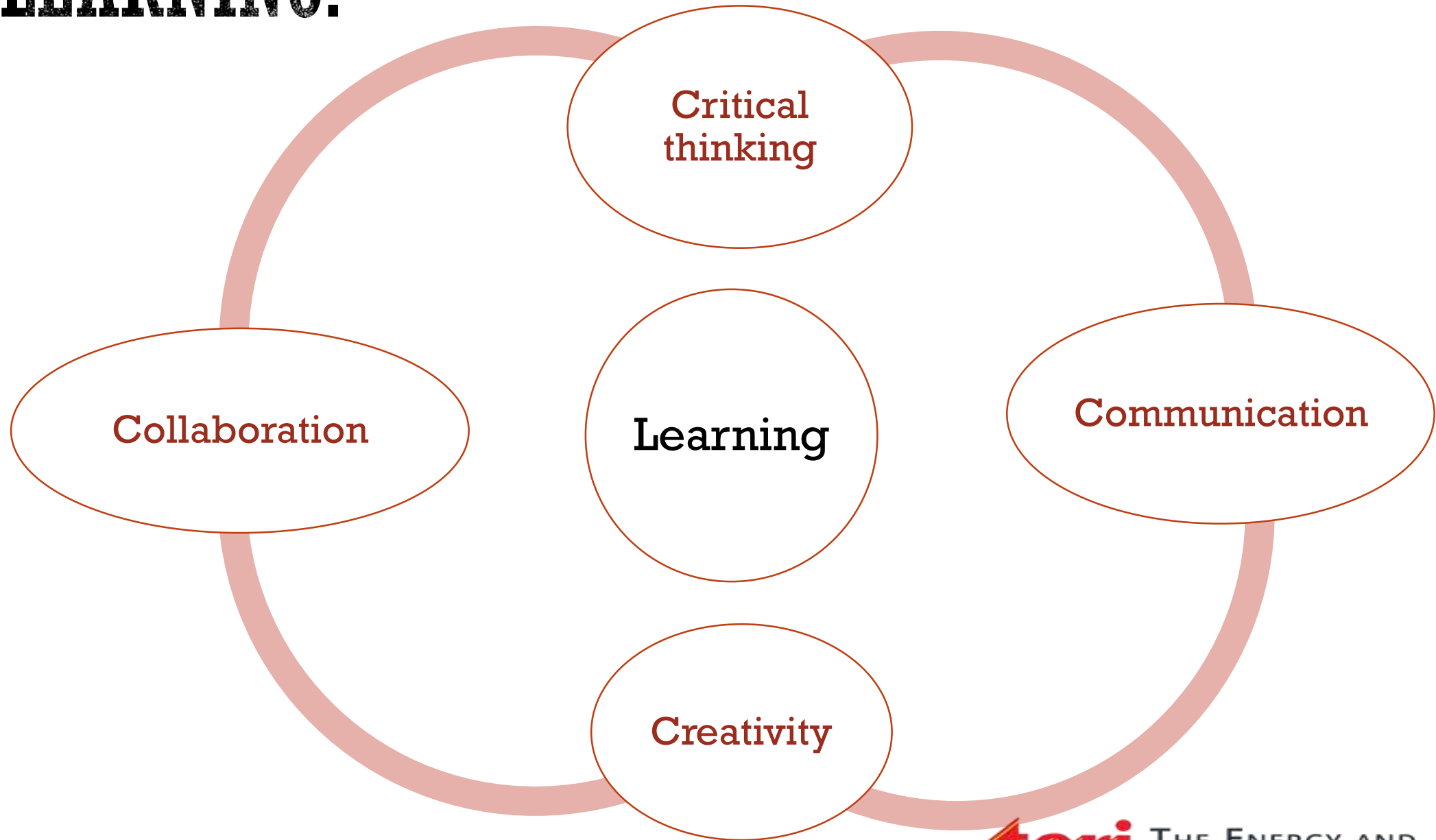
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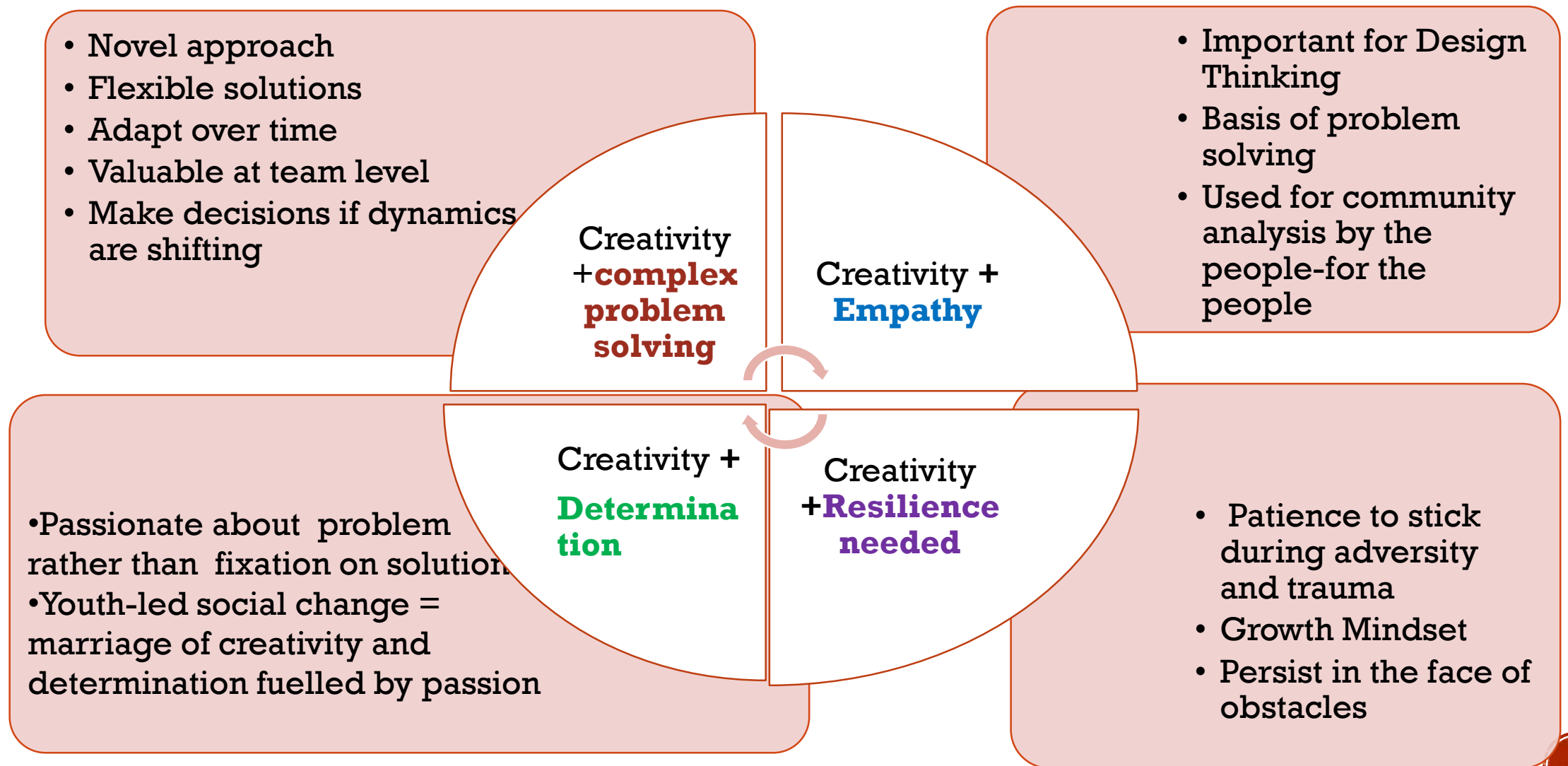
WHAT COMPRISES 21ST CENTURY SKILLS?

CRITICAL THINKING



- Improves the quality of thinking
- Observation-Analysis- Evaluate-Think- Plan of action with pros& cons-Implement-reinvent and improvise as and when required
- Emotional intelligence
- Perform problem-solving and decision-making more effectively



CRITICAL THINKING.....

- One must have an Unbiased manner
- Come up with reasonable conclusions based on that analysis
- Increase Creativity and better decision making with this skill
- One must be curious, compassionate, honest , willing and uphold ethics
- Decisiveness is the most important aspect
- Helps develop HIGH ORDER THINKING SKILLS (HOTS)

DIFFERENT COLLABORATION STYLES:

- **The Contributor:** Task-oriented team

- **The Coordinator:** Goal-directed team

member who sees the vision or goal of the team as the most important, but is flexible and open.

- **The Communicator:** Process-oriented team

member who is an effective listener and facilitator of involvement.

- **The Challenger:** Questions the goals and

methods of the team, and is willing to disagree with other people in charge.
